Proposals for a quality EU Youth Dialogue

We, as youth delegates, representatives of INGYOs and Youth Councils, had a reflection session and a strong dialogue with ministry and commission representatives to tackle several concerns about the EU Youth Dialogue which were brought up at this conference.

As a result; we call for

- A **coordination group** [steering committee] on the European level is needed in a form of a **permanent body**, ensuring sequence, consistency and common objectives of each of the Cycles.
 - 1. It should consist of the Trio presidency [involving the National Youth Councils], European Youth Forum, European Commission and other identified actors when relevant
 - 2. In its mandate, a consensual approach and joint solutions should be the foundation of the process, putting partners on an equal footing;
 - 3. Improve Quality management;
 - a. Ensure a good handover between cycles and phases of transition
 - b. Establish an evaluation mechanism of the process
 - c. Create a long-term feedback loop and reflection process to make sure the cycles build on each other and learn from previous challenges and good practices
 - d. Offer counselling for new presidencies to learn about the processes and build on already taken improvements
- Involvement of the National Youth Councils and National Working Groups in the presidency and governance process.
 - 1. Consult NYCs and the NWGs on regular basis to ensure their contribution and expertise is recognised:
 - a. NYCs and the NWGs hold the responsibility to include and reach young people through the dialogue and participatory approaches
 - b. NYCs bring the knowledge about non-formal and pedagogical methods how to ensure meaningful youth participation
 - c. NYCs are informed about topics important for youth and needs of youth
 - d. NYCs are low threshold and in close contact with young people
 - 2. Ensure NYCs get the needed finance for participating in the process and fulfilling the political demand of including wider groups of young people
 - 3. Ensure the NYCs as representing body of young people are recognised as such
 - 4. NYCs and the NWGs should be involved and shape the process and methodology of the EU Youth Dialogue and the Conferences
 - a. Making possible a direct constructive dialogue between policy makers and youth on EU level and on a regular basis
 - b. Making sure that the cycle has an overall sequence and the conferences build on each other
 - c. Making the EU Youth Dialogue youth-friendly, accessible, inclusive, participatory and meaningful with regards to policy processes
- Strengthening National Working Groups
 - 1. There should be regular international meetings between the NWGs and other actors, such as the coordinating body, aiming to build the capacity and ensure regular exchange.
- Support a **cross-sectoral approach** for the whole process

We hope that in this way, we can establish a European spirit of working together on a meaningful EU Youth Dialogue and ensure a constantly improving participation of youth on all levels of decision-making. We hope to strengthen the implementation of the Youth Goals and ensure that no ideas will be lost in ineffective structures. We hope for an inclusive and long-term effective European Youth Dialogue. We hope for a better Europe.
