

Participants


The Youth blended mobility will gather **40 participants** from Romania, Slovenia, Greece and Belgium.

Timis County Youth Foundation (FITT) was founded in 1990. It is a public utility umbrella organization for 31 youth and student NGOs.

Moreover, FITT...

- owns the Youth House, an 11.000 m2 building
- is focusing on youth participation and youth policies;
- is the only youth center in Romania accredited by the Council of Europe with the Quality Label for Youth Centres (2016-2023) and one of 14 such centres in Europe.

By plane

Timisoara has its own airport. If you can not find convenient options, close airports are Budapest, Belgrade or Oradea. If there are more people arriving in the same airport out of Timisoara, we could arrange for a shuttle bus.



By Flixbus/train

The closest big city is Budapest where you can take a flix bus or train to Timisoara. From Belgrade, there is no public transportation, so only shuttle bus is available.
