
ABOUT THE VOLUNTEERING ACTIVITY

The volunteering activity consists into 5 working days/week, 30-38 hours/week.






VOLUNTEERING ROADMAP

- Enthusiastic for cultural events, planning and promoting them,
- Excited to develop new skills in organising, implementing, and promoting cultural activities,
- Having residence in a EU country, or other country eligible for ESC, not requiring a visa (because of time limitations)




Timis County Youth Foundation (FITT) was founded in 1990. It is a public utility umbrella organisation for youth and student NGOs.

Moreover, FITT is:

- A model of democratic behavior;
- Focusing on youth participation and youth policies;
- Has more than 32 years of existence;
- Has 33 youth and student organisations as members;
- Owns the Youth House, an 11.000 m2 building that is the only youth centre in Romania accredited by the Council of Europe with the Quality Label for Youth Centres (2016-2023) and one of 14 such centres in Europe.

Timisoara is a special city. Everybody feels it, those who were born and live here and those who come here and then decide to stay.

As a true youth city, Timisoara received the title of National Youth Capital. The implementation of the 1st edition has been under FITT's coordination from 2nd of May 2016 until the 1st of May 2017.

Timisoara has got many things to offer, such as:

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

Your accomodation will be provided by us. You will stay for 1 month in a room that has 2/3 single beds (meaning you will share the room with one or two more people), bathroom and a shared kitchen.

The meals will be your responsibility: you will have a kitchen to use and you'll receive weekly allowance 5 EUR – food allowance/day, and of course, you'll receive pocket money too, 3 EUR/day (this money you will receive in romanian currency in cash, or by bank transfer).





INSURANCE AND TRAVEL

All the volunteers involved in the project will benefit from health insurance issued by the insurance company under the European Solidarity Corps.

Travel expenses will also be covered through the project based on the amounts established under the programme. - A short presentation with the most relevant info about your country (the main cities, the most visited places, local traditions, creative games or quizzes);

- Food and traditional drinks from your region;
- The recipe of traditional dish(es).

*These are just some suggestions, you can bring whatever you want.




CURRENCY AND WEATHER



Our National currency is RON: 1 euro = 4.9 RON

In Timişoara, the summers are warm, the winters are cold and dry, and it is partly cloudy year-round. Over the course of the year, the temperature typically varies from -5°C to 30°C and it is rarely below -10°C or above 35°C.
